

Suranaree University of Technology Announcement On

Code of Practice for Campus Entry and 2 Facilities on Campus during COVID-19 Circumstances

Following the previous Suranaree University of Technology Announcements on Preventive and Monitoring Measures in Response to the Coronavirus COVID-19 Outbreak, it is of utmost importance to guarantee health safety for everyone working and living on campus. Therefore, Suranaree University of Technology (SUT) deems it crucial to issue this announcement of code of practice for campus entry and 2 facilities on campus during COVID-19 circumstances, as follows:

1. Entry to SUT campus

- 1.1 All SUT students and staff entering SUT campus through any of the the 4 gates from 9pm to 5am must scan their student or staff identity cards at the check point for the security guards to keep record of their entry.
- 1.2 SUT requests the outsiders to refrain from entering the university premises from 9pm to 5am. In case of emergency or necessity, they must notify the security guard at the check point and scan their national identity cards or other official documents for the security guards to keep record of their entry.
 - 2. Services at SUT student dormitories
- 2.1 Student dormitories are open from 5.30am to 9pm, starting from April 17th to 30th, 2021 or until further notice.
- 2.2 All their service rooms and facilities and communal areas are closed from 9pm, starting from April 17th to 30th, 2021 or until further notice.
- 3. The Sports Centre will shut down all its indoor facilities such as the fitness centre, the swimming pool, the aerobic exercise room, the yoga and sport dance room, the squash court, the bike tour room, as well as all outdoor sport venues from April 17th, 2021 onwards or until further notice.
